Dear Parents

During this term your child will be studying the following theme:

Homes

In English and Maths we will be:

- Exploring language in various role play situations and extending vocabulary
- Learning about some traditional tales
- Continuing through the phonic programme
- Segmenting and blending to read simple words and sentences
- Learning about and how to use non-fiction books
- Forming recognisable letters
- Using letters to communicate meaning
- Learning to record using tally charts and graphs
- Becoming more familiar with number facts
- Learning about 3D shapes and identifying them in the environment
- Learning to combine groups of objects (addition) using Numicon
- Learning about signs, symbols and labels e.g. road signs
- Ordering pictures of our routes to various places we visit
- Ordering two or more objects by length
- Learning about times of the day
- Counting beyond 20.

If you would like to help your child in their study, you could undertake the following activities:

- Work on letter and number formation.
- Search for things in the environment that are flat, pointy, sloped, round, curved, straight as well as discussing the name of the shape; 2D and 3D.
- Use the flash cards sent home to make words for your child to read. Ask your child to spell a word using the cards and practise the formation of the letters.
- Point out and discuss road signs.
