Dear Parents,

During this term your child will be studying the following theme:

What is treasure?

In English and Maths we will be:

- Exploring a range of books in which the characters have something precious to them.
- Sharing our weekend activities and special things from home with each other and groups of friends.
- Learning to recognise and write our name. The activities that will take place to support this will include: tracing shapes, tracing our name, writing our name free hand, making large circular movements using chalk, pens and ribbons.
- Exploring rhyme and alliteration.
- Learning to sound talk – sound out words verbally.
- Learning strategies to make counting easier.
- Recognising domino spots arrangements.
- Learning the properties of 2D shapes e.g. corner, edge and side.
- Using language such as more and less to compare quantities.

If you would like to help your child in their study, you could undertake the following activities:

- Ask your child to practise forming the letters in their name correctly (ensure they start in the right place), e.g. on a steamed up window.
- Search for things that are flat, pointy, sloped, round, curved, straight etc. Do not necessarily focus on the name of the shape.
- Play snap.
- Play dominoes.
- Sound things out when talking to your child e.g. go and get your book b-a-g.
