In Expressive arts and design we will be:

- learning and singing a range of minibeast songs such as: 'The ugly bug ball', 'There's a worm at the bottom of the garden' and 'There's a spider on the floor'
- making observational drawings of minibeasts ٠
- composing music for different minibeasts
- studying the artist Matisse and copying his famous 'snail' picture
- create 3D snail art using clay.

In Understanding the world we will be:

- learning about different types of minibeasts finding out about where they live and what they eat
- comparing things such as how many • legs/wings minibeasts have
- explore how to navigate a path using an iPad or electronic device.

In Physical development we will be:

- developing co-ordination, control and spatial awareness
- completing various athletic activities to • develop jumping, throwing and running skills
- moving like different types of minibeasts. ٠

Homework/Family learning

Look at minibeasts you may find in your garden or whilst out and about. Discuss numbers of legs/wings and how they compare to other minibeasts in their habitat

In Mathematics we will be:

- looking at different sizes of minibeasts and making comparisons
- identifying patterns in nature e.g stripes on bees, spots on ladybirds
- looking at symmetry related to butterfly wings
- collecting data about minibeasts making pictograms related to our favourite type of minibeast and answering questions about the data collected
- doubling and halving using the spots on a ladybird •
- counting up to 20 and beyond when hunting for minibeasts.
