Dear Parents.

During this term your child will be studying the following theme: <u>London</u> Please see overleaf for an overview of this theme.

The core subjects of English and Maths are outlined below, although links with the theme will be made where possible.

English

- > To read high frequency words and phonically decodable words.
- > To re-read books to help with fluency.
- To recognise capital letters and full stops when reading, naming them correctly and applying them to writing.
- > To say out loud what they are going to write about.
- > To write a sequence of sentences.
- > To re-read what has been written and begin to improve writing.
- > To join words with 'and'.
- > Name letters of the alphabet in order.

Maths

- > To count on in ones from any number to 100.
- > To give the number one more or less than a given number to 100.
- > To recognise the value of the tens in two digit numbers.
- > To understand the operations of addition and subtraction.
- > To recognise coins and understand their values.
- > To recognise, name and discuss the properties of 3D shapes.
- > To recognise pairs of numbers and number bonds to 10.
- > To add 1, 2 or 3 to a number by counting on.
- > To read and write numbers and number-names to 20.

Please help your child in their study, with the following activities:

- > Read with your child every day, encouraging them to blend the sounds that make up the word.
- > Practise number and letter formation.
- Practise speaking in full sentences and writing them down with capital letters and full stops.
- > Mental maths activities including addition, subtraction, problem solving, number bonds and work with money.
