## Kit List for PGL UK Centres

Suitable nightwear x2

Underwear (extra is advisable)

Socks (that cover ankles for many activities)

Trousers/leggings for activities (not jeans)

Shorts

1 pair of trainers for activities

1 pair of waterproof shoes (old trainers are ideal)

Dry shoes for evening activities

Fleeces/sweatshirts

Long sleeved shirt/t-shirt (for activities where arms need to be covered)

T-shirts

Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)

Baseball hat/sun hat ( weather dependent)

1 or 2 sets of clothes for the evening

1 towel for showering

1 'old' towel for wet activities

Roll on deodorant only

# Frequently asked questions:

What communication can I expect to receive? –The school will update the website/ Seesaw/ parentmail to let you know that they have arrived safely and how everything is going.

Can my child bring their mobile phone? No

Can my child bring their electronic device / digital camera? No

In the event of an emergency, how can I contact my child's group leader? In the event of an emergency, you would contact the school, and they will contact the leaders.

Will they get enough food to eat? Food is plentiful at PGL, and they can help themselves to the salad bar, as many times as they want.

Which teachers are going with the group? Mr Worton-Geer, Miss Goodman, Mrs Stockwell and Mrs Hutchinson

Are there first aiders on site? There are numerous first aiders on site, as well as Fawbert and Barnard's staff who are first aid trained.

My child has medication – what do I need to do next? Let Mrs Hutchinson know and she will talk over your child's requirements with you.

What happens if Covid19 is still an issue? If there is a case within the class bubble, children will return early.

Can they bring spending money? Yes, the children can bring £10.00 with them. They do not need more, as there is not really much for them to buy.
