Freshly baked bread, seasonal vegetables and bowl salads are available daily along with our salad bar. There are also a wide range of desserts available each day. See the photos of today's options available. The school have discussed unpopular items with them and the menu will be tweaked for September onwards to provide an alternative for these. The following items will be removed from the menu:

Chicken Mayo Wrap (Week 1 Tuesday; Week 2 Tuesday; Week 3 Wednesday) Tomato & Cheese tart (Week 2 Tuesday) Quorn pattie in a bun (Week 2 Thursday) Savoury Quiche (Week 3 Thursday)

All of these will be substituted by a Jacket Potato option served with either Cheese or Beans selected at the counter. Children are also being given the choice of having gravy or not at the counter, rather than the meat being cooked in the gravy.

The problems with the school's dinner ordering system are still being worked on and we hope these will be resolved very shortly. In the meantime, please make a note or snapshot of your requests before submitting the form to us for your records.
