# REMINDERS

## School Uniform and Nail Varnish

Children should only be wearing black school shoes or ankle boots, ugg boots and knee length boots are not part of our school uniform. A number of children are wearing nail varnish to school, this should be taken off on a Sunday evening or Monday morning.

Navy or blue hair bands, clips etc should be discreet designs and only used in order to keep hair in place.

Watches may be worn during the school day but must be removed for PE lessons and are the responsibility of the pupil. They can be digital or analogue.

#### Leave of Absence requests

We understand that following the past two years of COVID, a holiday is much needed by all. The current law does not give any entitlement to parents to take their child out of school during term time. The Education (Pupil Registration) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 prohibits Headteachers granting leave of absence to a pupil except where an application has been made in advance and the Headteacher considers that there are exceptional circumstances relating to the application. Applications should be made by using the school form available from the office and returned to the school giving at least 10 school days notice.
