COVID Testing

Guidelines have changed regarding self-isolating if you have symptoms or confirmed COVID -19.

Pupils who are showing symptoms, or have had a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test, should self-isolate and get a confirmatory polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test.

If a pupil tests negative and they feel well, they can stop self-isolating and return to school. If the pupil tests positive, they should continue to self-isolate in line with public health guidance.

Please remember to send us positive test results ASAP, so we can record the absence correctly and inform the school community and authorities that we have reported confirmed cases.


