Class e-mails

Change of contact details

If you or other contact members have changed mobiles or moved over the summer break, please ensure that we have these updated details to ensure we are able to contact you in an emergency and be in line with our safeguarding policy.

Charging of meals

School dinners are now $\pounds 2.20$ per day for those children in Years 3-6. All dinners need to be preordered in advance by completing our on-line form issued fortnightly. Please could you ensure that orders are completed by the deadlines set as we are unable to add any late additions so sandwiches will need to be provided for the weeks missed until a new order can be submitted. Suppliers are now finding it increasingly difficult to get their stocks and this is now impacting everyone. Any orders that are changed on the day to sandwiches will be charged for.

Parking

We are still receiving complaints from local residents of parents blocking their driveway and garages which are causing them to be late for their school drop-off/collections, work or appointments. We would therefore be grateful if you could be considerate in your parking around the area. There are two local car parks near the High Street which are free of charge for the first hour, a disused garage area in Chippingfield and also a limited amount of parking permits for the 3PR scheme that the school operate using the High Street car park that can be used.
