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REMINDERS

School Grid Dinner system

Please see our new menu available from 4 September 2023.

We would like to remind you that you are now able to order dinners on a daily, weekly or termly basis through this system.

Please ensure orders have been placed by 8:55 am each day, if not before. If your child is absent or changes their mind and you provide sandwiches, remember to go in and cancel their lunch up until 8:55 am on the day. If you have not cancelled the order and it comes to light during the dinner service, you will be charged for the meal that has been prepared but not taken. This also applies to

those who are entitled to either Universal Free School Meals (All of KS1) or income based Free School Meals where the school will be charged for the dinner not taken. Please help us save on wastage and save on our school budget and cancel if not required.

We will be calling parents for any child that has not ordered a dinner that comes to our attention at service time to provide us with sandwiches as their order has not been catered for.

PE Kits

PE kits should be worn to school on Mondays and Fridays for pupils in Year 1 to Year 6 from September 2023. There is a school track suit available from Top Form and other local outlets. Please see our uniform policy and website or further information.

<u>Earrings</u>

Earrings should not be worn to school in September so if you are planning this, please ensure they can be removed by 5 September when the pupils return to school.

<u>Birthdays</u>

We love to celebrate the children's birthdays and each Friday in our celebration assembly we all sing Happy Birthday to those who have enjoyed a birthday that week. We welcome children to wear one birthday badge on the day, but tiaras, sashes and other decorations should be kept for wearing at home.

Medications

If you take home medication such as asthma pumps for the summer, these should be returned on the first day of school. All medical plans will need to be updated within the first two weeks of the new term. Please pop into the office to see Mrs Ralph to confirm no changes are required and sign the plan.

Healthy Snacks

Children in EYFS to Year 2 are provided with fruit and vegetables for snack time as part of the government scheme to promote healthy eating. Children in Years 3-6 need to bring their own snacks and are encouraged to follow the same routine—crisps, chocolate bars and high sugar cereal bars are not acceptable and will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school day.
