# Contributions for school visits/activities

We strive to provide the best education possible for all the children and schedule visits and other activities to enhance their learning. These often provide a valuable experience that some children would otherwise not have the opportunity to access. Some of these events do involve a cost either for just transport to the venue (such as swimming to enable them to meet the national curriculum 25 metre requirement) or an all inclusive day trip, where we ask parents for a voluntary contribution. We are aware of people struggling with the cost of living, but this is also impacting the school where we are experiencing huge rises in fuel costs, resources and everyday essentials which all need to come from our school budget. To assist us with balancing our school budget to provide these extras, we would be very grateful if all could contribute in some way to the costs requested where possible as detailed in each visit letter. If you are experiencing any financial constraints please do come and speak to a member of the Senior Leadership Team so we could arrange an alternative, installments, later payment timeframe or part-payment contribution. Unfortunately, there may be times when trips will need to be cancelled due to lack of contributions received.

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### Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club is growing and is enjoyed by those attending. Sessions start at 7:30 am each morning and children arriving before 8:00 am are provided with a breakfast of toast and cereals that are available before being taken to class at 8:40 am to start their day. We still have availability and you can sign up for a single day or a week, whichever suits your needs. Odd one-off occasions may also be accommodated provided 24 hours notice is given.

If you are struggling with the cost of living, let us provide your child with their breakfast by sending them in one morning a week to try our service and have them ready to learn.
