<u>After-school Clubs attendance</u>

If your child has been allocated a place to attend an after-school club and is unable to attend, we would be grateful if you could let the club staff member or the office know. If your child is absent on the day due to illness etc we will already be aware, but we have had occasions where children are going home without us being informed so then need to contact parents to ensure they are safe, following our safeguarding procedures.

Leave of Absence

As part of the government's initiative to improve attendance our Attendance Officer, Clare Morgan regularly reviews the schools data and is leading with this. She will be writing to those where improvement is required and arranging meetings were necessary. More details of any absences and parents duties can be found in our Attendance policy available on our website and the link below.

If you are requesting a leave of absence for your child, please ensure that the school form is completed and your statement for seeking exceptional circumstances is attached. The form is available in the hallway entrance to the office. This should be given to the school at least **two weeks** before the absence so the school can have sufficient time to provide you with a response. Where a parent removes a child when the application for leave was refused or where no application was made to the school, the issue of a penalty notice may be requested by this school in accordance with the Essex Code of Conduct.
