- •Now children are in Year 5 they are able to walk to school by themselves.
- •If your child wishes to walk to school by themselves then please complete a letter that can be found in the office corridor under the staff photos. They cannot walk until I have confirmation from you. This can be returned to the office, myself or Mrs Abbott.
- •They can bring their phones to school if they are walking by themselves. These <u>MUST</u> be turned off and given to myself or Mrs Abbott at the start of the school day who will lock them in a secure cupboard until the end of the day.

Reading

- •It is expected that pupils read at home from a very early age.
- •In Year 5 it is essential that they read for a good 20-30 minutes a day at home.
- •All children have a reading book to read at home. This needs to be coming into school as this is the book that will be used when reading to an adult.
- Children are responsible for changing their own books. They are aware of this.

HOMEWORK

- •This is an essential part of their school work and helps to reinforce their learning. It is expected that pupils complete their homework independently now.
- •Half term grid upload to the class page and seesaw- choose an activity a week. Expected to upload to seesaw every Friday. Happy for the children to bring in their work for me to see.
- •Homework in senior school is nightly. We aim to prepare them for it and need your support in this.

School uniform

It is important that children wear correct uniform in school at all times.

The correct school jumpers and cardigans need to be navy blue.

Reminder of black school shoes or plain black trainers.

No earrings and long hair tied back.

No bracelets or necklaces.

No coloured lip balm/gloss. They can have lipbalm but only to be put on at break and lunch time if really needed.
